All applications to the First Year Group in Coláiste Daibhéid will only be accepted after the 1st of October and the closing date for receipt of applications is the 20th of October at 3.00. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

All transfer applications to the present First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth Year or Sixth Year Group in Coláiste Daibhéid will only be accepted after the 8/9/2023 and the closing date for receipt of applications is the 24/10/2023. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

All applicants to the First-Year Group will be notified of an offer of a place or refusal of admission by:	27/10/23
Successful applicants to the First Year Group must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission by completing and returning the Acceptance Form on or before:	Within 2 weeks after the Acceptance Forms and Letters of Offer are issued, in line with the Enrolment Policy. Date will be on the Letter of offer form.
Note: Failure to accept an offer of admission before the relevant deadline set out above may result in the offer being withdrawn.
